Code of Conduct Form

Because we want to provide the best possible experience for every camper, ATC has developed policies designed to ensure a safe, productive and friendly camp community. In order to do so, we ask all of our parents and campers to read the following rules and agree to the policies outlined in this contract. Your signature on this application indicates you and your child's understanding & agreement with these policies.

CHILD'S NAME _____

1. No camper may use or have possession of any illegal drug or alcohol while at ATC Summer Theatre camp. No camper may use or have possession of cigarettes, or other tobacco products, cigarette lighters, or matches.

2.) All medications, including over-the-counter drugs and vitamins, must be kept in the Camp Office. (*Inhalers, epi-pens, and other life sustaining items may be kept by the camper.*)

3.) Inappropriate behavior, violence or intimidating language is prohibited. Campers may not physically strike anyone, under any circumstance. Campers, staff, and parents agree to respect all members of the ATC programme and will refrain from abusive or intimidating language or mistreatment of any kind.

4.) Campers agree not to deface or destroy property, (including graffiti) at The International Preparatory School or The Gil Vicente Theatre. Parents will be held financially responsible for any damages to school or theatre property.

5.) Campers may bring cell phones with them but at the beginning of each day phones will be switched to silent and put with their personal belongings. Campers may not receive or make calls during the day. Parents wishing to reach their child during the day are requested to call the Directors' mobile phone as provided.

6.) ATC and its staff, directors, and employees shall not be responsible for camper's personal possessions lost or damaged by theft, malicious mischief, or otherwise. We specifically advise campers not to bring jewellery or other valuables to camp.

7.) The undersigned (parent/guardian) understands that part of the theatre programme includes a performance before a paying public. The undersigned hereby give permission for the camper to take part in the performance with neither extra fee nor compensation. The undersigned hereby also grants to ATC the right to use any performance, photograph, film, or videotape in which the camper appears for broadcast, publication, advertising or exhibition.

The undersigned have read the above rules and understand and agree to all policies.
